For the above mentioned topics you will find bibliography, abstracts, articles, unpublished reports, statistics, information on implemented projects, 'good practice' examples, links to organizations, and upcoming events.

The wiki contains practical as well as scientific information. It aims to be a resource databank for experts and researchers but also for health and social care professionals, for members of the migrant and minority communities, for policy makers and the public at large.

Information from the site will be used for compiling a 'state of the art' report in the summer of 2008. This report will be posted on the site and will be disseminated nationally.
